



Sun Oaks Summer Camp 2017

Welcome to Sun Oaks Summer Camp 2017! Our goal is for every child to create memories that last a lifetime!

We believe camp will be a happy, fun, and an active atmosphere for your camper! We are so excited to have you this year! Summer camp is Monday through Friday from 8AM to 2PM.

Ages 5(MUST HAVE FINISHED KINDERGARTEN) TO 12.

Registration: Registration for Sun Oaks members will begin April 24th and for non-members will begin on May 1st. All registrations are available online at www.sunoaks.com.

Payment: Camp operates on a first come first served basis. Payment is due at the time of registering.

Refunds/Schedule Changes: All schedule changes/cancellations must be made 2 days in advance. No refunds after Wednesday for the upcoming week of camp. No makeup days for missed days.

Pick up & Drop off: Sign your child in at the Camp Information Desk located across from the Playhouse. Please sign your child out of camp at the outdoor pool with a camp counselor. All children must be signed in/out daily. Your child must be picked up by 2PM. If you are unable to pick up your child make sure you have other adults listed on the registration form as authorized to pick your child up. Please be sure they bring photo I.D. We will be checking. If your child is not picked up at 2PM and they are under the age of 8, they must stay in the after camp program. Sun Oaks babysitting service is available to campers from 2-5PM. Your child will be supervised by Sun Oaks babysitting staff. The cost is \$12 per day per child. This ensures that they have someone to help them through the long day. Children 8 and older and are members of Sun Oaks are welcome to swim under life guard supervision after camp hours or use the club facilities. Parent permission is required for campers who will be signing themselves out of camp at 2PM but remaining at the club. If you have a child who is 8 and older, but you would still like them to have the supervision of a staff member you are welcome to sign them up for after care by Monday morning the week camp starts.

Electronics and Belongings: Electronics at Sun Oaks Summer Camp are not encouraged.

If your camper is attending after care he/she may drop off any electronics with a counselor. It will be held until the end of the camp day. There is no tolerance for electronics during camp. Sun Oaks cannot be held liable for anything lost, stolen, or damaged.

Activities and Dress code: Camp is designed with weekly themes and daily activities. Counselors take their team to different stations that implement the weekly theme. During the week a special guest who is passionate about our theme will come teach an activity that the week is based on. Camp will also have an assortment of water and swim activities. The goal, this summer, is to stay active with fun and engaging activities. Please remember that we will be playing with water daily, as well as swimming. Please prepare or dress your camper accordingly! And don't forget a towel! Sunscreen will be available but please try and bring your own.

Spirit Thursday: Every Thursday is Spirit Thursday! Campers can enter our Spirit Thursday contest by dressing up as our weekly spirit theme. Campers can earn a prize for themselves and participation points for their team!

Lunches and Snacks: A snack a day will be provided for campers. If your camper has a specific allergy it is advised he/she bring their own snack. Please let a camp counselor know if your camper has any specific allergies! When registering for camp you are given the option to order lunch for your camper as well. If you have not been able to order your campers lunch you will be given the opportunity to do so at the Camp Information Desk. Drink Cards will also be made available at the front desk.

Behavioral Policy: To maintain a safe and fun program for everyone, we occasionally ask children to take a “time out.” Campers will always be given the option to come out of a time out if they are ready to have fun and safely participate! Should inappropriate behavior, continue campers will be sent to the front office. Parents will be notified and the camper will be asked to leave for the rest of the day.

Sick Policy: Health issues are a concern for everyone. Sun Oaks Summer Camp relies on each family’s thoughtful assessment of his/hers camper’s health. If a camper is sick he/she should remain home until he/she is able to participate and the fever or illness has been gone for at least 24 hours. Parents will be notified if their camper seems ill or becomes ill. Campers will be sent home.

Tax Information: Record keeping of the fees paid is the responsibility of the parent, please keep your receipts. The only information we can provide you is our Tax I.D. number: 35-2570085.

After-Care: Please note that after care is a \$12.00 fee
Campers in after care will either be swimming or participating in light activities provided by the after-care counselor. Children will always be ready for pick up at the Sun Oaks Playhouse at 5:00 pm. On a very hot day it is possible for aftercare campers to have the opportunity to watch a movie. Movies are always reviewed before watching. Please keep in mind movies like “Finding Dory” are rated PG.
